Carpet Information

CARPET IS AN INVESTMENT THAT WILL LAST FOR YEARS TO COME, WITH PROPER INSTALL AND REGULAR CARE.

To enhance the life and performance of your carpet, there are a few things to keep in mind:

CARPET SEAMS - in most installations, carpet seams are *inevitable*.

Even with the most experienced installers, you will be able to detect what is called a "seam rise" likely due to 3 things:

With the additional thickness of the seam tape and the heating process used for installation, carpet seams "peak". This will be more noticeable in lower profile or patterned carpets.

The "arching" of the seam tape stretched during the installation process.

If the carpet is a "cut pile" or a straight strand (not looped), the blossoming or relaxing of the yarn during the ironing process can cause a seam. Strands may look fuller and stand taller. However, shearing the strands or settling over time will lessen this affect.

After installation: Vacuum your carpet to remove loose fibers. You may notice a new carpet smell, which will fade quickly. Ventilate the area for 48-72 hours. If you are sensitive to odors or allergy-prone, you may want to avoid the installation area during this time.

Pad color: The actual color of the carpet pad may be different than the sample you originally looked at. This **WILL NOT** affect the look or pattern of your carpet. Sometimes manufacturers change fibers or processes and the pad color differs. **Your carpet will still match the sample you picked out for your project.**
